# ZOTZENBERG

## MITTELBERGHEIM



**T**he Zotzenberg basin lies on the south flank of the Mittelbergheim hillside, rising to an altitude of 320 metres.

**F**acing east and south, it enjoys privileged exposure to the sun. Its 36,45 ha consist of Jurassic limestone and marl, plus oligocene limestone-marl conglomerates. This combination ensures moisture retention and resists drought.

**F**ormerly renowned mainly for its Sylvaner, this vineyard enables Gewurztraminer, Riesling and Tokay Pinot Gris wines to become exceptionally expressive.

**I**nitially known as Zoczenberg (1364), Zotzenberg wines have the rare privilege of being sold under the vineyard name ever since the beginning of the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

**T**hanks to their limestone-marl origin, Zotzenberg Grand Cru wines are famous for their great finesse and exceptional body, and are wines which will keep for many years.
