## The Estate:

Herdade do Perdigão is located in the heart of Alto Alentejo, near Monforte. An area covered by the microclimate of São Mamede mountain, responsible for the unique and differentiated *Terroir* found here.

## Winemaking and Viticulture:

The wine begins in the vineyard, where a strict control during all year to deliver the best fruit at harvest. The following is an extreme rigor and care in harvest to lead the grapes at the optimum point of ripeness to the cellar, where the winemaking team, using the most modern winemaking criteria, turn it into wines with the seal of Herdade do Perdigão.

## Villa Romanu – The modern interpretation of a culture with 2000 years.

It is believed that the vine cultivation in this region has roots in the Roman occupation of the Iberian Peninsula.

Modern wines, young and easy to drink, they are able to please the most cosmopolitan consumers.

Colour:	Dark rubi.
Aroma:	Fresh red fruit with some minty spice.
Taste:	Round with well marked fruit.
Finishing:	Young, smooth, elegant.
Food paring:	Light stews
Service temperature:	16°C

## Technical information:

Harvest:	Handpicked for cases of 25 kg
Vinification:	After sorting, the fully stalked clusters fermented in stainless steel tanks with temperature control for, approximately, 10 days.
Grape Varieties:	Trincadeira, Aragonez and Cabernet Sauvignon
Lab analysis:	Alcohol – 14% Total Acidity– 5,6 g/L pH – 3,75 Total sugar – <0,3 g/L
